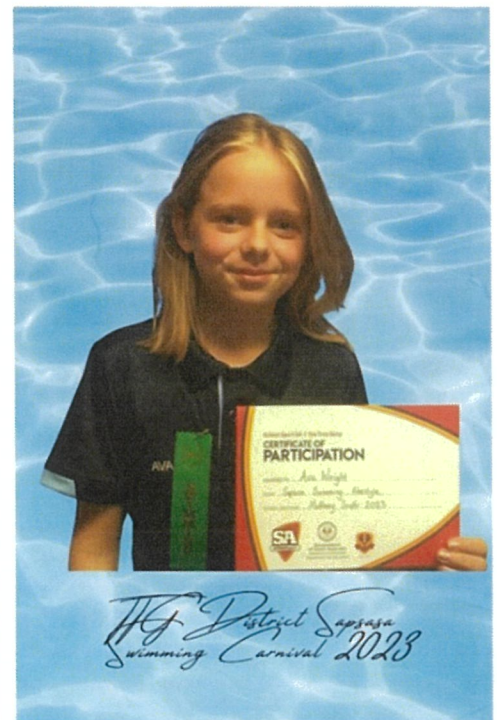
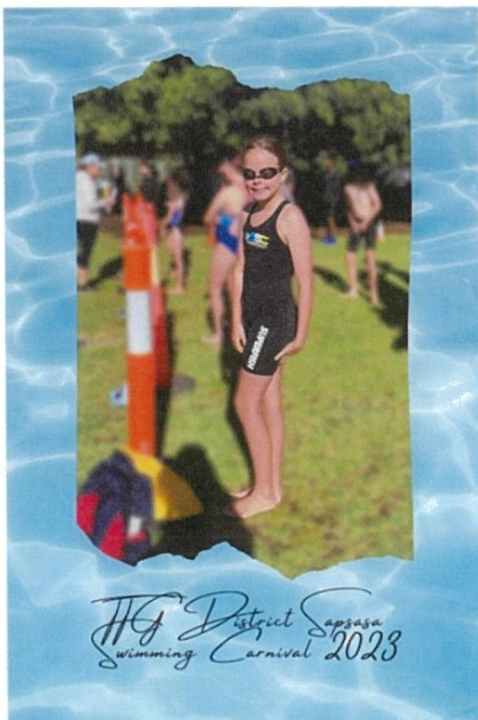

## Term 1 Sapsasa Results

Week 5 Friday 3rd of March, Modbury South had one student participate in the Tea Tree Gully, Salisbury & Para District Sapsasa Swimming Carnival held at Waterworld. Ava W nominated for 2 events which were the Open Girls 100m Freestyle and the 50m Freestyle in her age group. Ava's mum provided the following statement;

# Sapsasa Athletics

Week 9 Tuesday 28th of March, Modbury South participated in the Tea Tree Gully Sapsasa Athletics carnival at Bulkana Oval, Banksia Park.

Modbury South had 16 students compete in a range of track and field events. These events were the 100m sprint, 200m, 400m, 800m, high jump, long jump, discus and shot put. Notable individual achievements on the day were:

- Jaxon finished 3rd in the 2012 Boys 400m with a time of 101.93 seconds.
- Nataniel finished 5th in the 2012 Boys High Jump with a height of 105cm.
- Max qualified for the 200m final.
- Miki qualified for the 200m final.
